1. Molto - Much
2. Poco A Poco - Little by Little
3. Beat - Steady pulse of the music
4. Rhythm - The organization of sound and silence
5. Interval - The distance between 2 pitches
6. Half Step - The interval that is the smallest
7. Whole Step - An interval that is made up of 2 half steps
8. Major Scale - A scale that is made up of a specific pattern of half steps and whole steps - WWHWWWH
9. Minor Scale - A scale that is made up of a specific pattern of half steps and whole steps that is different than the major scale - WHWWHWW
10. Rubato - Freely slowing down and speeding up the tempo without changing the basic pulse
11. Caesura // - Also known as a grand pause. A sudden silence in the music.
